

## VILLAGE OF DELIA

## BY-LAW No.104 OF THE VILLAGE OF DELIA

A BY-LAW of the Village of Delia to provide for the levy of a Mill Rate under The Town and Village Act for the year 1940.

WHEREAS the Village of Delia in accordance with para 347 and para 5 of Chapter XI of the Town and Village Act 1934 is required to levy a sufficient rate for the general purposes of the Village of Delia upon all assessable land, together with all buildings and improvements thereon as will be sufficient to produce the amount of the difference between the total expenditure as estimated by the Council less the amount of the estimated probable revenue of the Village.

THEREFORE the Council of the Village of Delia hereby enact that a levy of  $\$5$  Mills on the Dollar be made against all rateable land and buildings and improvements thereon in the Village of Delia which is liable to assessment and taxation for general revenue purposes for the year 1940.
