

By-Law No.105 of the Village of Delia authorizing
Current Municipal Tax Levy

WHEREAS, the estimated expenditure for the Village
of Delia for the year 1941 is \$4325.09 as per
estimates in detail duly recorded, and
WHEREAS the total assessed valuation of Taxable Property
within the Village as shown by the Assessment Roll is
as follows,

AND WHEREAS it is estimated that the sum of \$ 1314.00
will be collected from sources other than a
current taxes Levy, thus leaving the amount
to be collected from current levy \$ 3011.09
To which is to be added for no-collection \$ 844.14
Making the total current taxes to be levied \$ 3855.23

THEREFORE, the Secretary Treasurer of the said
Village is hereby authorized to raise the said amount
namely \$38.55.23 by a levy upon all rateable property
therein, at the rate of 25 Mills on the Dollar of
assessed value for Municipal purposes.
