By-Law No. 114 of the Village of Delia authorizing Current Levy Municipal Tax Levy.
WHEREAS the estimated expenditure for the Village of Delia for the year 1943 is \$4054.92 as per estimates in detail duly recorded and
WHEREAS the total assessment valuation of the taxable property within the said Village, as shown by the Assessment Roll is as follows:-

Land \$ 41718.

Buildings & Improvements \$112186

Special Canadian Utilities Ltd \$ 9800.

AND WHEREAS it is estimated that the sum of \$2685.00 will be collected from sources other than Current Levy thus leaving the amount to be collected from Current Taxes \$1560.00

which is to be added for non-collection \$900.00 making the total Current Taxes to be levied \$2410.32
WHEREFORE the Secretary Treasurer of the said Village of Delia is hereby authorized to raise the said amount by \$2410.32 by a Levy upon all rateable property therein at a rate of 15 Mills on the Dollar of assessed property values for Municipal Purposes.
