

By-Law 124

Authorizing the Current Municipal Tax Levy

WHEREAS the estimated expenditure for the Village of Delia for the year 1945 is \$3527.00 as per estimate in detail duly recorded; and

WHEREAS the total assessed valuation of taxable property within the said Village, as shown by the assessment roll, is as follows;

AND WHEREAS it is estimated that the sum of \$1,026.00 will be collected from sources other than Current Levy thus leaving the amount to be collected from current taxes ..... \$2496.00 ... to which is to be added for non-collections ....\$400.00 ... Making the total Current Taxes to be levied ... \$2896.00 ...

THEREFORE the Sec Treas of the said Village of Delia is hereby authorized to raise the said amount, namely \$2896.00 by a levy upon all rateabel property therein, at a rate of 20 mills on the dollar of assessed value, for municipal purposes (this rate included 2 mills for hospital purposes with a minimum of \$6.00 for each ratepayer who owns rateable property) Done and passed in Council assembled this 12th day of June 1945.
