

BY/LAW NO. 216
VILLAGE OF DELIA

A by-law authorizing current village tax levy, Drumheller School Division, Drumheller Municipal Hospital requisitions and the Canadian Utilites Limited business tax.

WHEREAS the estimated expenditure for the Village of Delia, including the requisition of the Drumheller School Division and the Drumheller Municipal Hospital for the year 1957 is \$28,691.26 as per statement in detail duly recorded. WHEREAS the total assessed valuation of taxable property within the said Village, as shown by the Assesment Roll is as follows:

Land	35,000
Bldgs. & Imp.	330,615
Bus. Tax Assess.	174,385
Can. Utilites	116,200

AND WHEREAS it is estimated that the sum of \$23,790.00 will be required to be collected for the current year levy, therefore the secretary of the said Village is hereby authorized to raise the said amount, namely \$23,790.00 by a Levy of:

14 mills on the dollar on land, improvement, business tax assessment assessed at 540,000 which equals 7,560.00 and 10 mills on the dollar on assessment of Canadian Utilites Limited which equals 162.00 for Municipal purposes.
27 mills on the dollar on land, improvements, Business Tax Assessment assessed at \$540,000 which equals \$14,580.00 for school purposes.
3 mills on the dollar with a \$10.00 Minimum per taxpayer on land, improvements, business tax assessment assessed at \$540,000 which equals approximately \$1990.00 for hospital purposes.
