

BYLAW NO 245

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF DELIA TO AUTHORIZE THE RATE OF TAXATION IMPOSED FOR THE YEAR 1961.

WHEREAS, the total requirements of the Village of Delia as shown in the estimates of revenue and expenditure are as follows:

MUNICIPAL.....\$ 6,165.00
SCHOOL REQUISITION.....\$15,321.00
Hospital Benefits.....\$ 1,122.96

WHEREAS the total assessment of land, buildings and improvements amounts to \$ 381,350 and

WHEREAS the estimated revenue other than from taxation is \$22,545.51 and

WHEREAS, the rates hereinafter set out are deemed necessary to provide the amounts required for Municipal, School and Hospital purposes, after making due allowance for the amount of taxes which may reasonably be expected to ~~remain~~ remain unpaid.

NOW THEREFORE, by virtue of the power conferred upon it by Section 353 of the TOWN AND VILLAGE ACT, the council of the Village of Delia enacts as follows:

THAT the Secretary-Treasurer, be and is hereby authorized and required to levy the following rates of taxation on the assessed value of all lands, buildings and improvements as shown on the assessment and tax roll:

Municipal purposes..... 10 mills on the dollar
School purposes..... 30 mills on the dollar
Hospital Purposes..... 4 mills on the dollar

AND on the assessed value of all businesses as shown on the Assessment and Tax Roll:

Municipal purposes..... 10 mills on the dollar
School purposes..... 30 mills on the dollar

Read a first and second time and by unanimous consent of the councillors present, a third time and finally passed this 27th day of June, 1961.
