

BYLAW NO. 331

A By-law of the Village of Delia to authorize the rate of taxation for the year 1972.

WHEREAS, the total requirements of the Village of Delia are as follows:

WHEREAS, the total assessment of lands, buildings and improvements amounts to \$458,240.00 and WHEREAS, the rates hereinafter set out are deemed necessary to provide the amounts required for Municipal, Education and Health and recreation purposes, after making due allowance for the taxes that may reasonably be expected to remain unpaid.

NOW THEREFORE by virtue of the power conferred upon it by Section 93 of the Municipal Assessment and Taxation Act, the Council of the Village of Delia duly assembled enacts as follows:


THAT the Secretary-Treasurer be and is hereby authorized and required to levy the following rates of taxation on the assessed value of all lands, buildings and improvements as shown on the Tax Roll:

AND on the assessed value of all businesses as shown on the Assessment and Tax Roll:
