

BYLAW NO. 336

A By-law of the Village of Delia to authorize the rate of Taxation for the year 1973.

WHEREAS, the total requirements of the Village of Delia are as follows:

Municipal.....	\$19, 392.87
Education.....	15,561.00
Recreation.....	1,284.72

WHEREAS, the total assessment of lands, buildings and improvements amounts to \$471,865.00 and

WHEREAS, the rates hereinafter set out are deemed necessary to provide the amounts required for Municipal, Education and Recreation purposes, after making due allowance for the taxes that may be reasonably be expected to remain unpaid.

NOW THEREFORE by virtue of the power conferred upon it by Section 93 of the Municipal Taxation Act, the Council of the Village of Delia duly assembled enacts as follows:

That the Secretary-Treasurer be and is hereby authorized and required to levy the following rates of taxation on the assessed value of all lands, buildings and improvements as shown on the Tax Roll:

Municipal Purposes.....	30 mills on the dollar
School Foundation	8 mills on the dollar
Starland School Division..	16 mills on the dollar
Recreation Purposes.....	3 mills on the dollar
Total.....	57 mills on the dollar

And on the assessed value of all businesses as shown on the Assessment and Tax Roll:

Municipal Purposes..... 40 mills on the dollar

Read a first, second and by unanimous consent of the Councillors present a third time and finally passed this 12th day of June, 1973.
