Bylaw # 554-05

A Bylaw of the Village of Delia in the Province of Alberta, to authorize the rate of taxation for the year 2005.

Whereas the total requirements of the Village of Delia are as follows:

WHEREAS, the total assessment on lands, buildings, and improvements amounts to \$6,640,680 and

WHEREAS the rates hereinafter set are deemed necessary to provide the amounts required for Municipal, Education, Planning Board, Fire Department, Library, Senior and Ambulance purposes, after making the due allowance for the taxes that may reasonably be expected to remain unpaid.

NOW THEREFORE by the virtue of the powers conferred upon it by the Municipal Taxation Act, The Council of the Village of Delia, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

Despite the tax rate for each class, the minimum tax levy for municipal purposes on each residential property shall be not less than \$200.00 except for partially exempt properties and where one property be joined to another primary property with improvements and owned by the same owner. If the two properties together do not have the required assessment, the tax levy will be \$200.00 or 400.00 for the total parcel.


