Province of Alberta
By-Law #600-12

Being a bylaw of the Village of Delia, Alberta to repeal bylaws that are ineffective and/or have subsequent Bylaws in place for those matters.

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of Section 63 of the *Municipal Government Act*, Chapter M-26, Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000 as amended;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Village of Delia, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

Definitions

2 In this Bylaw the following words shall be defined as:

- (a) "Act" means the *Municipal Government Act*, Chapter M-26, Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000 as amended.
- (b) "Council" means the Council of the Village of Delia.
- (c) "Village" means the Village of Delia or its duly authorized representatives


Conditions

3 The Council hereby repeals Bylaw #180, a bylaw to establish a curfew for children, and Bylaw #548, Curfew Bylaw.


In Force




