



Village of Delia – Utility Bill and Monthly Pre-authorized Property Tax Deferral

At the April 9th meeting, council voted to allow a deferral of Village utility bill payments and monthly pre-authorized tax installment payments in response to the Covid19 pandemic. Details are as follows:

Utility bill payments can be deferred for 90 days (April, May & June bills). Penalties will not be charged and there will be no disconnections during this time. Services will continue to be charged and bills will be sent out during this time but payments will not have to be made. Once the 90 day deferral period is up, arrangements can be made for a scheduled re-payment. Full re-payment of the bill will still need to be made; **this is not a waiver of amounts owing.**

Pre-authorized tax installments: to those property owners currently making monthly tax payments; the payments can be deferred for 90 days without penalty. When the 90 day deferral period is up, arrangements will need to be made for payment of property taxes.

Council wants to help residents and businesses that are struggling with finances as much as possible during this tough time but reminds everyone that these are deferrals of payments, not payment waivers. If you can afford to make your utility and tax payments as usual, it is recommended that you do so.
