

Policy #4 – Water Line & Valve Infrastructure Maintenance

Approval Date: January 11, 2018

Policy Statement

This policy applies to water shut offs when there is construction or maintenance required.

Procedure

- 1. For new installation, see Policy #2 Municipal Utility Service for requirements.
- 2. When a valve or line requires maintenance, the Public Works Foreman shall advise the CAO and a project file is started and the following steps are followed:
 - a. Contact Alberta Environment to advise of work being proposed
 - b. You will be required to give them the following information:
 - approval #757-02-00
 - number of residents involved
 - how we are going to notify
 - c. Note reference number that Environment advises us for the file
 - d. Water tests are to be completed before & after at the site of work, upstream and downstream where valves are turned off:
 - bacterial tests
 - turbidity
 - chlorine
 - e. When work is completed, contact Alberta Environment and advise
- 3. Advise residents by notice to be hand delivered the day prior to the work being proposed.
- 4. When the whole town is to be shut off, the following will be completed:
 - a. Notices will be posted at Post Office, Community Bulletin Board, Delia Store and Lukes Coffee Shop
 - b. Businesses will be notified directly, where possible
- 5. When there is an unscheduled or emergency interruption of water service, the Public Works Foreman and the CAO will be notified as soon as possible; the Fire Chief will be notified of possible water shortage in case of emergency.
