Village of Delia Province of Alberta By-Law #597-12

Being a bylaw of the Village of Delia, Alberta to repeal bylaws that are ineffective and/or have subsequent Bylaws in place for those matters.

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of Section 63 of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26, Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000 as amended;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Village of Delia, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

Definitions

- 2 In this Bylaw the following words shall be defined as:
 - (a) "Act" means the *Municipal Government Act*, Chapter M-26, Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000 as amended.
 - (b) "Council" means the Council of the Village of Delia.
 - (c) "Village" means the Village of Delia or its duly authorized representatives

Conditions

- The Council hereby repeals Bylaw #423, Establishment of a Development Appeal Board, as Bylaw #580, Subdivision & Development Appeal Board is currently in place for this matter.
- The Council hereby repeals Bylaw #443, Nomination Deposit, as Council will decide by resolution if a Nomination Deposit is required in subsequent municipal elections.
- The Council hereby repeals Bylaw #470, Theft of Firewood, as this would be dealt with under the Criminal Code (R.S.C., 1985, c. C-46).
- The Council hereby repeals Bylaw #476, Tourism Action Committee.
- 7 The Council hereby repeals Bylaws #514, #529, Appoint Designate Officers, as subsequent Bylaws are in place pursuant to the Act, Section 210.
- The Council hereby repeals Bylaw #551 & #570, Establish the position of CAO, as Bylaw #572, Establish CAO Position & Share Services is currently in place, which more clearly describes the position for the Village.

- The Council hereby repeals Bylaw #316, Mobile Home License Fees, as the Village does not have a Mobile Home Park and all residential properties are taxed as per the Act, Part 10, at a single mill rate decided annually by the current Council.
- The Council hereby repeals Bylaw #212, Responsibility for Breakage and/or plugging of Water and Sewer Pipes, as a current Utility Services Bylaw is in place for this matter.
- 11 The Council hereby repeals Bylaw #205, Water and Sewer Permit Fees, as this is covered under the current Land Use Order.
- 12 The Council hereby repeals Bylaw #206, Water Meters, as this is no longer in effect.
- The Council hereby repeals Bylaw #494, Establish Inter-Municipal Planning Agency, as Bylaw #497 is in place for this matter.

In Force

This by-law shall come into full force and effect on the day that it is finally passed by Council by giving it third and final reading and it is signed in accordance with the MGA.
