

Village of Delia - Province of Alberta Bylaw 671- 2025 - Snow Removal

Being a bylaw of the Village of Delia, Alberta to control and regulate the removal of snow and ice from the sidewalks within the Village.

This is an amending Bylaw to amend Bylaw 637-2019 items 3 and 9 contained in Conditions section of the Bylaw.

WHEREAS

the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26 Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000 as amended from time to time, is the authority for Councils to enact bylaws respecting the safety, health and welfare of people and the protection of people and property within the boundaries of the municipality;

AND WHEREAS Council deems it desirable to have clean and safe sidewalks and public spaces;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Village of Delia, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

Conditions

- 3) The owner or occupant of any premises abutting a sidewalk shall clear away any snow and ice from the front and flank of the abutting sidewalk within seventy-two (72) hours after the time such snow and ice was deposited or formed on the sidewalk.
- 9) In the event that the owner or occupant of a parcel of land fails or neglects to remove and clear away all snow or ice from a sidewalk within the specified seventy-two (72) hours, the Village may cause the snow or ice to be removed from such sidewalk and invoice the cost of the remedial work (plus a 10% administration fee) to the owner of the said parcel of land.

In Force

13) This bylaw shall come into full force and effect on the day that it is finally passed by Council by giving it third and final reading and it is signed in accordance with the Municipal Government Act.

Read a first time this day of 11th day of March, 2025.

Read a second time this day of 11th day of March, 2025.

Motion to allow for third and final reading passed unanimously by Council this 11th day of March, 2025.

Read a third time in Council and passed this 11th day of March, 2025.
