2.1 ACP GRANT

Res 175-2025

Mayor Thomas Trout moved that the Village of Delia supports the submission of a 2025/26 Alberta Community Partnership grant application in support of the Regional Waste and Wastewater Infrastructure Management Study project and is prepared to manage the grant project and related compliance requirements. There is no matching contribution required. Carried.

2.2 AMWWP Grant

The estimated project cost is up to 1,985,000 over six years, based on the official population of 152, the estimated eligible project costs would be calculated under a 75% provincial grant (\$1,488,750) /25% (496,250) municipal contribution cost share arrangement.
